Important Advice for Module Selection in the International Semester

During your International Semester, you have a lot more options than choosing study modules. These are:

- A) German Class (Introduction Level or Higher): 6 ECTS
This is chosen by almost all students, and compulsory.
- B) Orientation Programme and German Seminar, 3 ECTS
This is chosen by all students, and compulsory.
- C) This is Germany Class: 3 ECTS
This is chosen by all students, and seen as compulsory.
- D) Project: as group project: 6 ECTS
This is an option, with projects selected in week 1/2

Thus, you usually choose 18 to max. 24 ECTS in study modules.
