Important Advice for Module Selection in the International Semester

During your International Semester, you have a lot more options than choosing study modules. These are:

- A) German Class (Introduction Level or Higher): 6 ECTS This is chosen by almost all students, and compulsory.
- B) Orientation Programme and German Seminar, 3 ECTS (FH 16329) This is chosen by all students, and compulsory.
- C) This is Germany Class: 3 ECTS

 This is chosen by all students, and seen as compulsory.
- D) Project: as group project: 6 ECTS

 This is an option, with projects selected in week1/2

Thus, you usually choose 18 to max. 24 ECTS in study modules. Please read the structure again:

Please note for the week of October 5 (1st week of lectures) and the registration processes:

1) it is the first week of completely starting with online teaching ever! This week will certainly require some practice for all parties. Thus, please be patient, if during the first few days, not the complete **information is provided on Felix for each and every course**. For example, professors might use the Alfaview Video Conferencing (VC) tools, which is currently in the testing/scaling phase. Thus, registration for this VC tool and the use for lectures might not directly start next week. Thus, please recheck the Felix-accounts for the courses during the first week for updated information.

2) Professor Karduck will keep you updated during the first week of all courses for the International Semester.

- 3) As communicated by Professor Karduck, students of the International Semester are of course able to have a look at various courses, and finally decide and **register until** October 22.
- 4) Professor Karduck has provided the International Semester students with information about the special registration process for **Digital Media courses. This has to be done this week (week of October 5).**
- 5) For all other courses, please use the **attached Registration Document**. Thus, the courses you like to register for has to be included into this PDF and sent to the registration office. For International Semester students, please send the PDF to Mrs. Böhler via Email: boa@hs-furtwangen.de

Video-Conferencing Tools used by Professors

The current status is, that we will start with online teaching in the week of April 20. **FELIX will be the key repository for all course related documents and notifications.** For the Digital Media related courses, a seperate registratio and repository is used, as described above and in the previous emails.

Online teaching means, that some professors might load up their lecture presentations with audio explanations in FELIX, along with references. Others will give online lectures, e.g. with Alfaview, Zoom, or other tools, complemented by lecture slides etc. Most probably, a mix between FELIX-documents and Online Lectures will be delivered. The times and procedures will be described in FELIX for by the professor for each lecture. Thus, book the courses in FELIX as described above, to get this information.

Usually, you would have had the first 2 weeks time to get an impression of the various lectures you are interested in, and then finally decide and send the attached registration document to Mrs Böhler. With online, we like to give you the same flexibility.

Video conferencing in Alfaview is based on the idea of **Rooms**, that you join. You will be provided with information in FELIX for each course, which room will be used (by a link shared). Alfaview is intuitive to use.

To summarize for the course descriptions in FELIX:

All courses contain on their respective start page important information on, amongst other, these topics: - *When* will the class take place? (synchronous ("live") or asynchronous ("recorded")) - *Where* will the class take place?" (the virtual classroom's URL) - *How* will the class be held? (tools and communication methods)

Additionally, all Felix-courses / classrooms contain communication tools and channels through which you can get in touch with your teacher and / or fellow students.

As the information in your Felix courses / classrooms can be updated by your teacher at any time throughout the semester, you can be sure that you will always have access to current information on your class.
