Important Advice for Module Selection in the International Semester

During your International Semester, you have a lot more options than choosing study modules. These are:

- A) German Class (Introduction Level or Higher): 6 ECTS This is chosen by almost all students, and compulsory.
- B) Orientation Programme and German Seminar, 3 ECTS This is chosen by all students, and compulsory.
- C) This is Germany Class: 3 ECTS

 This is chosen by all students, and seen as compulsory.
- D) Project: as group project: 6 ECTS

 This is an option, with projects selected in week1/2

Thus, you usually choose 18 to max. 24 ECTS in study modules.

- b) **Important:** For the courses of the Faculty of **Digital Media**, the course registation takes place **already the week before the semester starts**. This is from **September 26-30**, **2022** for the autumn semester, as informed by the International Center during the Orientation Program.

For all other courses, please use the **attached Registration Document**. Thus, the courses you like to register for have to be included into this PDF.

Important 2 step process:

Step 1: Approval of your Learning Agreement by Professor Karduck on October 17, 13:00-14:00 at the International Center

Step 2: Bring the signed Learning Agreement to the Academic Registrar, Mrs. Carola Frank on October 17-19. Please state to Mrs. Frank, that you are International Semester student.

Please note: The faculty of Digital Media has a separate, direct registration procedure, as mentioned above. This will be introduced to you during the Orientation Program.

Your final Learning Agreement will of course list as well the Digital Media courses.
